Trinitarian Logic

“Trinitarian Logic:

Paul and Apollos are one and the same. Paul did not precede Apollos and Apollos did not precede Paul, because they are one. Apollos is not lesser than Paul and Paul is not greater than Apollos, because they are one.

1 Corinthians 3:6 I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase.

(Verse 8) Now he that planteth and he that watereth are one...

The apostle is 3 in 1. There is Paul, Apollos and the spirit of man. It's a mystery, but just believe it. Paul doesn't know the things of man. The things of man are known only by the Spirit of Man, or more accurately Man the Spirit. Man the Spirit is the personality that represents Paul to others.

1 Corinthians 2:11 For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him?

Paul is really just a metaphor for one third of the apostle. Apollos is another third and the Spirit of Man is the next third. They can change roles any time and the apostle will still be comprised of 3 personalities. Paul isn't really the one who converted Apollos. It's just beyond our capacity to comprehend that Apollos was never actually converted because he was always converted the same as Paul. We just say that Apollos was converted to make it easier to understand, even though it's not true. It's just a metaphor..."

Just today I got this story from Naik in India:

“Last night it was amazing, there was an open Door Gospel meeting among the different religious brothers & sisters. The lord Jesus Christ has given us wonderful opportunities to speak out and give a strong testimony about who Jesus is, why he came on this planet, what the Father in heaven has done through his begotten son Jesus Christ for all of us.

Mr. Jeevan is a very strong religious person. He follows his religious lifestyle without any doubt and he never compromises in his responsibilities to offer sacrifices to whom he worships.

This open door meeting was organised by Mr Jeevan, who is very strong & sensitive in his religious activities in himself and his wife, with two young educated daughters are very strong devotees for what they believed since they were born in their religion, but one of her relative accepted Jesus Christ as her personal Saviour, she worships the Father and Son Jesus Christ in the spirit and truth.

But Mr jeevan's family never ever want to hear about Jesus Christ because they are so committed devotees in there religious activities and lifestyle, many times we have been visiting his village to share the crucifixion of Christ and his sacrifice on the cross for human kind but Mr Jeevan and his family did not pay their attention to hear what we were preaching in their village.

One fine morning he and his family decided to take baptism, to be children of GOD. We baptized them in Christ, then interesting things happened, his community people along with relatives started to discriminate against them because of their uncompromising Faith in Jesus Christ.

They were told by GOD to organize a Big open door Gospel meeting among their Hindu community's people as well as relatives, this happened last night, nearly 120 People came forward to hear About Jesus Christ, we used this amazing opportunity to share the truth.

All understood who Jesus Christ is and his love for each one of them, raised their hands towards heaven to Cover their lives in Jesus hand's. Brother Jeevan and family members are very happy and thankful to Jesus Christ. I hope and trust Gospel seeds one day grow in their lives with the latter rain of the Holy spirit.
