3.) Violation of church manual reasons for discipline #11 (pg. 68 of the 2022 SDA Church Manual, 20th Edition): "Persistent refusal to recognize properly constituted church authority or to submit to the order and discipline of the church."

As previously revealed to the board of elders, both of you (______ & _____) have expressed theological beliefs that do not adhere with the Seventh-day Adventist Church beliefs with regards to the Trinity and more specifically the nature of Jesus Christ & the Holy Spirit. In accordance with church manual instructions and Matthew 18 principles; these are the actions..."

They have loved and served in the Seventh-day Adventist church for their whole lives.
