RE: IMPLEMENTATION OF ELECTRONIC TRAVEL AUTHORIZATION (eTA)

Following the Presidential directive during the 60th Jamhuri Day celebrations on 12th December, 2023 that Kenya will be a visa free country from January, 2024, the Directorate of Immigration Services has developed a digital platform www.etakenya.go.ke to ensure that all travellers to Kenya are identified in advance through an electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) system.

Henceforth, all travelers coming to Kenya will be required to apply and pay for the electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) prior to travel, with exclusion of the


Just like towing the van to West Virginia, I was able to tow a broken down truck today for someone who could use the help. If you're on Instagram or Facebook, you may have seen this:
