Update on the 'Farm'

I'm positive we don't have much more time to get ready for the troubles before us as Christians. My family and I have realized together that we've got to start growing our own food (I know... I've lived out of the cities long enough, some 20+ years, but I still don't have a beautiful garden to prove it!). Anyway, we FINALLY have our own home and things are starting to get finished on the inside of the home (finishing our first home purchase, etc), so now... soon... it's outside we go.

Well, after several months of looking, asking at least a dozen people, praying, etc, about a tractor (after the first one found a better home, as God put it on my heart to donate it to a brother who also could use it), I realized that I wasn't going to get a decent tractor like I was hoping for without paying almost full price, like for a new one. I'd save about 15% or so if it were used (four wheel drive—a necessity here in Georgia, and backhoe compatible), and then God worked it out. Here's how.

I was driving by a place in town I had been by 100 times thinking, "I should pull over there some time..." Then I said, "Okay, now's the time."

Well, the tractor type I was looking for was the very last one they had. It was a discounted price because the new company that bought them out wanted to bring their new tractors onto the lot... It was perfect timing. The next day I called and said, "Oh! I need to get a backhoe arm. Could



you please order one?" The guy there said, "yeah, no problem. They are about 547 bucks." He called me back about a minute later and apologized. He saw that since the last time he had ordered one they had gone up almost double! He said, "Well, since I had told you that price, do you mind meeting half way at \$750?" Again, perfect timing. Praise God.

There are three reasons why I believed a tractor is a good idea in this setting: helping people who don't have a tractor (similar to how the trailer has been used; that has been such a blessing in so many ways! In fact, a few days after getting the tractor I got a call from my neighbor who

wanted to borrow the trailer again, but I told him I had taken off the wheels to change out the seals and bearings. He then explained that he'd be stuck there a while because he had a leaking pipe in his field and was about to start digging... well... I drove on over and had him fixed up in about fifteen minutes, and it would have taken him several hours in this hardened clay!) The second reason is emergencies (floods, tornados or storms, etc. I've been involved in a lot of situations where a tractor has either been used or would have been a good thing to have), and finally the local farm. We are doing what we can to get busy gardening because of the serious events around us. It's going to get ugly soon—described by a video presentation entitled, "Joseph and the Common Good." If you haven't seen that one, you might be interested. It was presented at the Graysville OTG church in TN. A great group of people.

Finally we reached villages, rain stopped, and whole village people wondered after seeing us, because we look like aliens from heaven. spiritual food. I experienced, what is true in the rain, because it's the cold season in India, on top of it super heavy rain in deep forest, i don't have words to explain my situation at that time. I pray father in heaven, please make it bit hot weather for Indian people in heaven...ha...ha . Glory to God. Simple living lives in the forest villages, 98% Catholics occupied the villages by building Big churches and schools and hospitals in whole Odisha state. I never seen one Adventist Church or Sabbath keeper family in my 3 days of visit of 10 village's. I believe we are the first people entering with 3 angels messages and father and son truth in those places. When i started to share about angels messages to them, they are very happy to hear about God's angels helping and supporting in the spiritual journey. We trained our OTG missionaries, with different teachings of God, blessed them with help and Blankets, literatures. Light is shining in those souls for second coming of Jesus Christ.
