# A Bishop and a Vicar



# A Word from a Chef in Kenya

Taught how to cook in part by Remi Wilberforce, Sami's wife, Stephen in Kenya prepared incredible and healthful food for my daughter, L, and me while we ministered there in February. He wants to be a chef full time. Learn part of his story:

I have a younger sister who had been the eye of mum but currently she's developing eye problem which is leading her to loosing also her eyes.

She was forced to drop out of school because of her conditions.

This the burden that I have and God has been faithful in helping me to carry it.

### Bibles in Kenya

One of the ideas Pastor Milanda (the Pentecostal bishop mentioned before) had was to get a container for Bibles to keep them safe from the weather and to distribute them. I heard that idea as though God was speaking it directly to me. So, immediately after getting home from Kenya we have deliberated and concluded that the best location for the Bibles would be suited with a brick building instead of a metal container (because of the logistics of muddy roads in the rainy season, the time it would take to get the container, etc). So, here it goes! We will be building a 12x20 or 24 foot building to house Bibles in Ndhiwa, a central location for distribution.
